From 1st October The Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018 introduce an updated licensing system for five activities involving animals: selling animals as pets, providing boarding (including day boarding) for cats or dogs, hiring out horses, dog breeding and keeping or training animals for exhibition. showing on your phone if there is the small-
est signal from any of the networks it will
