

A reminder that there is a public access defibrillator mounted on the outside wall of the Village Hall. You don't need training to operate it as step by step guidance is given by

the device itself, it tells you what to do. The code needed to open the defibrillator cabinet should be available from the emergency services by dialling 999 (you will find that although you may not have a signal showing on your phone if there is the smallest signal from any of the networks it will work).
