Take Care of That Dog

There have been a few contretemps between dog owners/walkers and those they share the countryside with. There are allegations that an occasional off-lead dog has been aggressive to well-behaved pooches, perfect owners and very hardy hikers. There have even been a couple of crossallegations - impossible to sort out who was to blame.

The important thing is that the law always blames the dog and is fierce about letting dogs be "dangerously out of control" to the extent that if someone is frightened that a dog might attack them - even unreasonably - whether in public or private places, you can be prosecuted and your dog might pay the heaviest price. Most local dogs are soppy but can act fierce so for their sake keep them safely under your control.
