The plan aimsto pr ovide 'Rural Beat Officers' as the local face of the force; 'Rural Watch' to improve two -way between

officers and the public in rural areas; a more visible police presence in villages and hamlets; to target rural crime using new specialist Rural Policing Teams; to give rural residents the chance to voice their views on policing via panels run by the Constabulary in their areas; to improve the quality of contact between the police and public.




