

SPEED LIMITSDo Signs Spell Safety?



There is a view that the inherentur banisation that the signs bring with them willd tract from the rural nature of the villages and may out weight head vantages of the speed limits, given that 30 mphistoo fast for some parts of the village and may be largely ignored on the more open stretches of roads. Up to now the PC has been lobbying the Road Traffic Department for the limits. What doy out hink? Do we continue to pursue it or look for alternatives? Please let us have your views.

 $The proposed speed restricted zone covers Sevenha \\ Lane "(the one with the ford) all the way to Cotehay Cottages on the Winch comberoad, \\ Lower Sevenhampton, all of Brockhampton to just above "Elsdon View". It includes all the side roads. Park Lane and Gassons Lane are excluded.$

The speed limit will be 30 mph for the whole zone other than between Manor Farm and Brockhampton Park where it will be 40 mph. The rewill be 'terminal' signs (approx 2 ft diam.) on both sides of the road where the limit starts/ends and where it c hanges from 30 to 40 m.p.h. Smaller 'repeater' signs (approx 1 ft diam.) will be erected at intervals of about 200 m (220 yds) on alternate sides of the road in the 30 mph zones. The rewill be one set of repeater shalf way along the 40 mph zone.


