These items were raised at the well attended Annual Parish M eeting on March 17 th.


- Helpisneededtomaintainthe **Churchyardgardens** (see overleaf).

- **DogFouling** -isbecoming a serious problem -particularly along "the walks". Under the Dogs (fouling of land) Order it is an offence to a llow your dog to foul any "open to air" land designated by the district council to which the public has access. Apart from that, it is not very nice and can be dangerous for walkers, specially children, to encounter dog mess which has not been cleared up. **There is a stock of free "poopers cooper" bags in the post to ffice.**
