Parish Council Opposes Plan for Wind Turbine

SevenhamptonParishCouncilhasopposedaplanforawindturbinesited onManorFarmnearNashBarns.Theturbinewouldbemountedona 15metre(49ft)polewiththreebladesof2.5metres(8ft)inlength.Anestimateoftheamountofpowerproducedperyearisintheregionof 13,000kWh.Thiswouldhelpreducetheenergycostsonthefarm.

The council took its attitude after receiving letters from residents and hearing the advice of those present at an open meeting. Its reasons for opposition are on the grounds of: a) the danger of setting a precedent which would lead to further similar applications within the area; b) the perceived environmental impact across the valley and for the many walkers in that part of the AONB; and c) no is ein the immediate vicinity —there are two cottages immediately adjacent. The final decision rests with Cots wold District Council.


