will not take place this year


The annual evening of mince pies, punch & Christmas Carols will not take place this year.



This is the true story of a Detroit singer, Sixto Rodriquez who, in the early 1970s, recorded

two unsuccessful albums and then disappeared without trace. But a bootleg recording of him made it to South Africa and, unbeknownst to him, he became the Dylan-like inspiration for a generation of young South Africans.

In the 1990s a few fans decided to discover the truth of their hero's fate. He was rumoured to have committed suicide or died on stage.

What follows is a bizarrely heartening story in which they found far more in their quest than they ever hoped.

Though this film has had universal rave reviews on TV and in all the broadsheets it received no support from Cineworld et al so has been hard to find.
