

Ride and Stride, run by the Gloucestershire Historic Churches Trust, is a great way to support your church and churches across the county when they most need help. It's an annual sponsored walk, bike or horse ride which happens on the second Saturday of September.

Walkers and riders turn out to follow their chosen route between churches which open for the day. Many of them serve refreshments as well as checking you in and providing a friendly welcome, directions and moral support.
